

## MELGES 24 OPEN HUNGARIAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP BALATONFÜRED, LAKE BALATON NOTICE OF RACE

- 1.1 Location:** Balatonfüred, Lake Balaton, Hungary
- 1.2 Date:** September 22-26. 2010
- 1.3 Organizer:** MVM Partner Inc. and Hungarian Melges 24 Class Association
- 1.4 Race officer:** Tibor Hegedűs
- 1.5 Head of Jury:** István Hantó
- 1.6. Doctor:** Dr. Péter Szalóczy
- 2.1 Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in "The Racing Rules of Sailing" (2009-2012). The Hungarian General Sailing Instructions 2010 will apply. The regulations of IMCA and this NoR will apply.
- 3.1 Classes:** Melges 24
- 3.2 Eligibility:** International participants: The regatta is open to all boats that are member of a national Melges class association. The owner of the boat should hold a national class association membership.
- 3.3** The responsible person on the boat should also hold a national association membership.
- 3.4** The helmsman's club membership should be valid in accordance with the country's regulations that he is representing.
- 3.5** All crew members should hold a club membership of a club that is registered by its national sailing federation.
- 4.1 Date and place of entry:** Marina Koloska, Balatonfüred,  
6:00 – 8:00 pm 22. September, 2010  
8:00 – 9:00 am 23. September, 2010
- 4.2 Documents needed for entry:**
- valid health certificate (for Hungarian teams only)
  - MVSZ membership ( Hungarian teams only)
  - international measurement certificate
  - valid sailing licence (for Hungarian helm only)
  - valid boat certificate (for Hungarian boats only)
  - each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,5m EUR or the equivalent



- 4.3 Entry fee:** 9.000,-HUF/person (approximately. 30,-EUR/person)  
The entry fee is discounted by 50% for participants born after 01.01.1992
- 4.4 Weigh in:** Weigh in is compulsory at the time of registration. Teams shall weigh in wearing at least shorts and shirt and shall weight less than 360kg
- 5.1 Number of Races:** 12 races are scheduled.
- 5.2 Program:** 09:55 am, 23rd September – 1st warning signal of the first race, 2nd and 3rd race will follow
- 5.3 Starting times:** 09:55 first starts of the day, a maximum of 4 races may be held per day.
- 5.4 Last race:** The warning signal of the last race will not be made after 2:25 pm .
- 5.5 Prize giving:** Will be held after the last race. Notice of the exact time and place will be given on the notice board immediately after the last race.
- 6.1 Course:** windward - leeward course as per the attached diagram on the water between Balatonfüred-Siófok-Zamárdi-Tihany.
- 7.1 Marks:** yellow inflatable marks; starting and finishing marks will be marks with a striped flag.
- 8.1 Start:** Starting will be in accordance with RRS 26.
- 9.1 Race Committee Boats:** Race Committee boats will fly an orange flag on their masts.
- 10.1 Protests:** The time limit for lodging a protest is one hour after the race committee's arrival to shore. The end of protest time will be indicated on the notice board. There is no fee for protest.
- 11.1. Discards:** If there are 5 or more races, the worst race, if there are 9 or more races, the worst 2 races can be dropped.
- 11.2. Prizes** If there are 12 entries or less, prizes will be given to best 3 boats.  
If there are 13 or more entries, prizes will be given to best 6 boats.
- 11.3** The winner of the first race will receive the "Tóth László" award.
- 11.4** Prizes in the open category will be given to best teams, while there will be separate prizes for the Hungarian Championship.
- 12.1 Other** ISAF advertising code 20.4.1.1 is valid during the event. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
